lettered L, M, N. Distance number 9 kins, 4 uinals, 1 tun  
(L<sub>1b</sub>-M<sub>1a</sub>); (9.9.18.16.3) 7 Akbal 16 Muan (M<sub>1b</sub>-N<sub>1a</sub>);  
sundry glyphs of unknown meaning; distance number 17 kins,  
1 uinal, 1 tun (M<sub>3</sub>); (9.10.0.0.0) 1 Ahau 8 Kayab (N<sub>3</sub>).  
Note use of thumb to designate number 1 at M<sub>1a</sub> and M<sub>3b</sub>.
